# Self-Guided Curriculum JA BizTown®

■ Work and Career Readiness ■ Financial Literacy

The JA BizTown self-guided curriculum is a series of 33 self-guided topics that students can complete independently or together as a class. Additionally, the Primer is a foundational learning tool centered on civics and free enterprise concepts that acts as an introduction to both the classroom curriculum and the self-quided curriculum.

The curriculum emphasizes the rights and responsibilities of citizenship and provides visuals to students and educators to enhance the connections between individuals, the organizations they are a part of, and the community they live in.

Civics and free enterprise concepts and ideas are integrated into many self-guided topics to elevate the civics focus. Each topic, ranging from 5-10 minutes in duration, contains short animations, exploratory activities. and knowledge checkpoints. All knowledge checkpoints provide practice and constructive feedback to reinforce learning.

The self-guided topics can be used to:

- Prepare students for the onsite simulation.
- Prepare students for the Online Adventures.
- Supplement classroom materials.
- Reinforce and extend learning (for whole group or individuals).
- Assign to students who have missed part of the curriculum.

All self-guided topics are labeled to align with the unit and lesson in the classroom curriculum.



- Based on the civics enhancements from the classroom curriculum, the selfguided curriculum incorporates lesson objectives, concepts, and terms that reflect how civics underpins the daily lives of everyone in a community.
- Self-quided online learning activities include:
  - The JA BizTown Civics Primer.
  - Community and economy, work readiness, and civics and free enterprise content.
  - Engaging and informative visuals to assist students along their journey.



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## **PRIMER**

The Primer, a **pre-program** optional learning experience, provides students with background information about the founding of the United States and the basic structure of the federal government. This self-guided asset includes key documents such as the Declaration of Independence and the U.S. Constitution and a brief history of their development. The Primer also defines civics fundamentals and terms. It can be used prior to beginning *JA BizTown* curriculum or in conjunction with the curriculum. The Educator Overview includes suggested locations where Primer content will be appropriate.



#### SELF-GUIDED UNIT OVERVIEWS

#### **Unit 1: Financial Literacy**

Introduces students to basic banking principles in a free market economy. Students focus on the financial freedoms granted by the U.S. Constitution and Bill of Rights, and the rule of law.

### **Unit 2: Community and Economy**

Explains the circular flow of the economy in a free enterprise system. Students focus on citizenship, the circular flow of the economy, involvement of government, and the purpose of taxes.

#### **Unit 3: Work Readiness**

Introduces students to the process of entering the workforce and workforce readiness skills. Students focus on the rights and responsibilities of citizens as workers in an economy.

#### **Unit 4: Business Management**

Establishes the primary concepts related to managing a business in a free market economy. Students focus on the rights and responsibilities of citizens as business managers in an economy.

#### **Unit 5: Visit and Debrief**

Participate in the JA BizTown simulation and reflect on the experience. Students focus on performing their job responsibilities, managing their finances and time, and carry out responsibilities of citizenship.
